The Kevin Cruise Foundation is a response to this need.

WHAT'S BEEN GOING ON...

- This year we received grants and donations from Prince Philip Trust Fund, The Louis Baylis Trust, Shanly Foundation, AWBS Berkshire, Megan Jones School of Performing Arts, Berkshire Theatre School.
- This festive season we are giving out over 600 theatre tickets. By doing so we will be helping to support 3 local theatres, Theatre Royal Windsor, Norden Farm, Baylis Theatre.
- This year we have funded 6 students their full time fees and 7 students half their fees at the Megan Jones School of Performing Arts and Berkshire Theatre School.
- This year we funded students at the Theatre Royal Windsor's Easter musical workshops.
